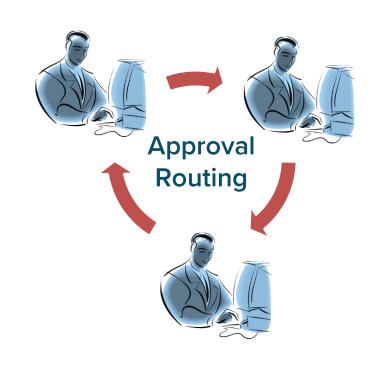




#### What is *Data-Driven* Approval Routing?

#### Data-Driven Approval Routing

is technology that creates and alerts a list of Approvers <u>based on the data</u> associated with a specific Process Request, and then performs an Action upon final approval of that Request.

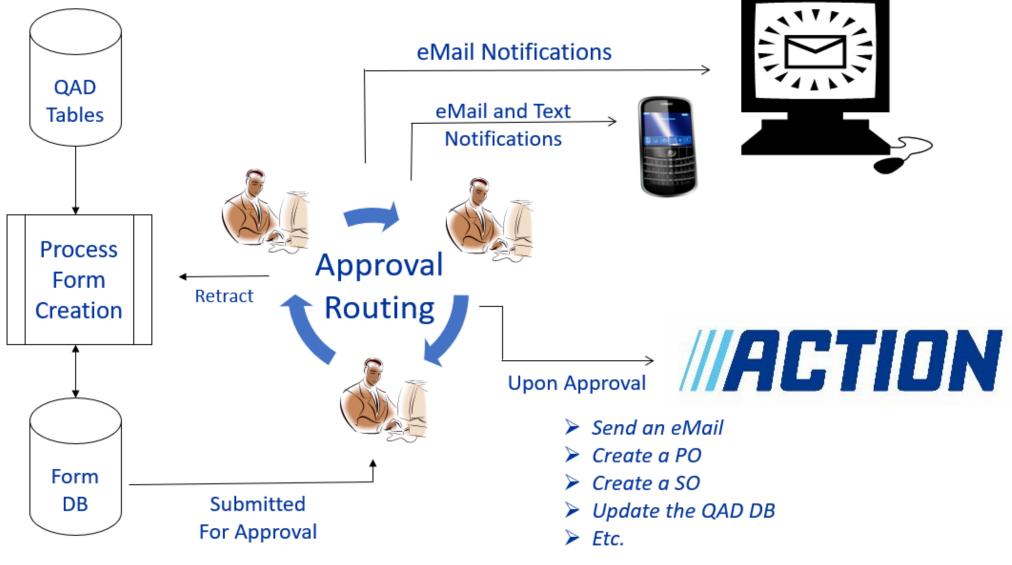

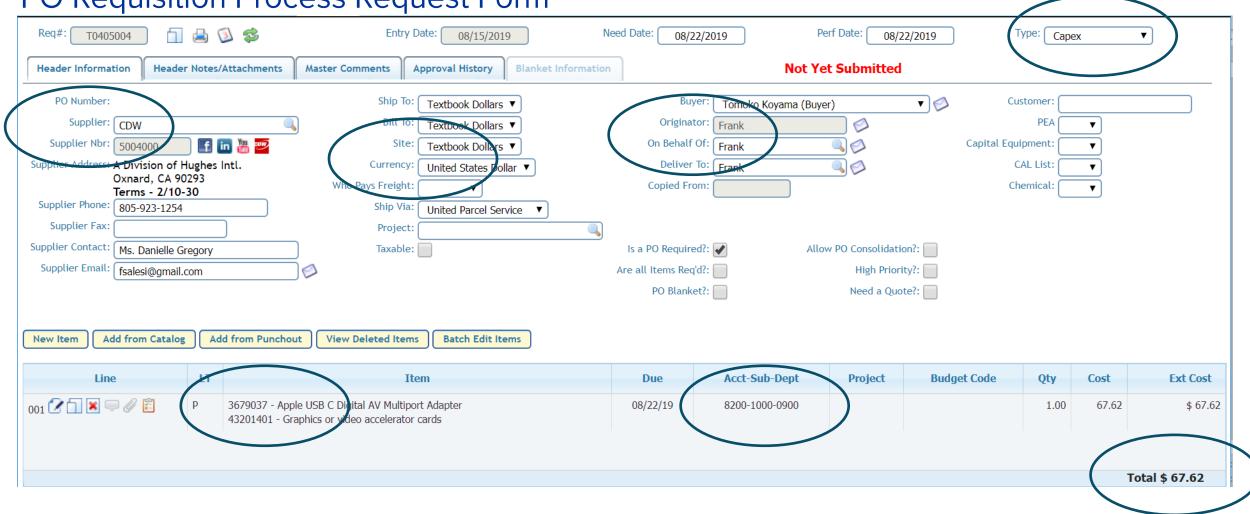

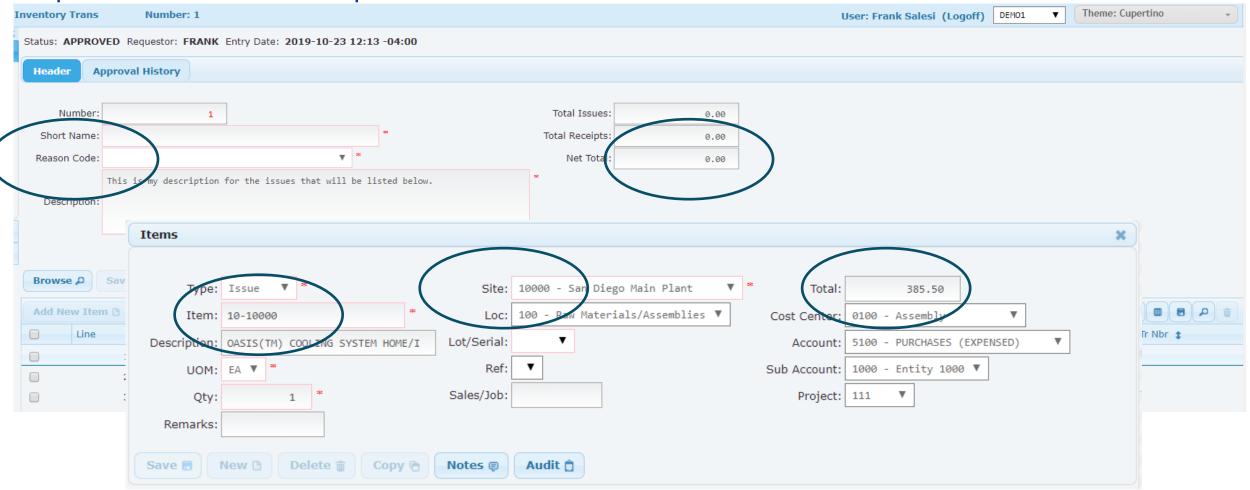






#### **Another Process Request Example**

Unplanned Issues/Receipts



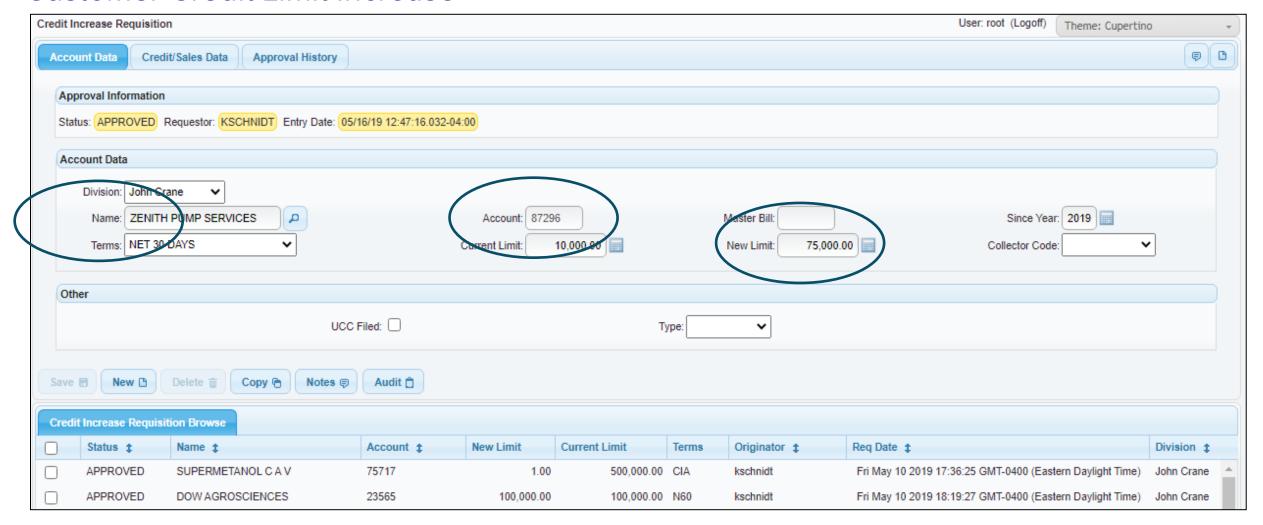

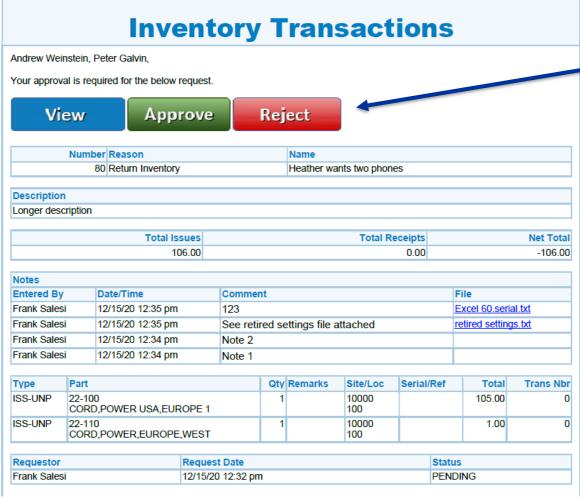

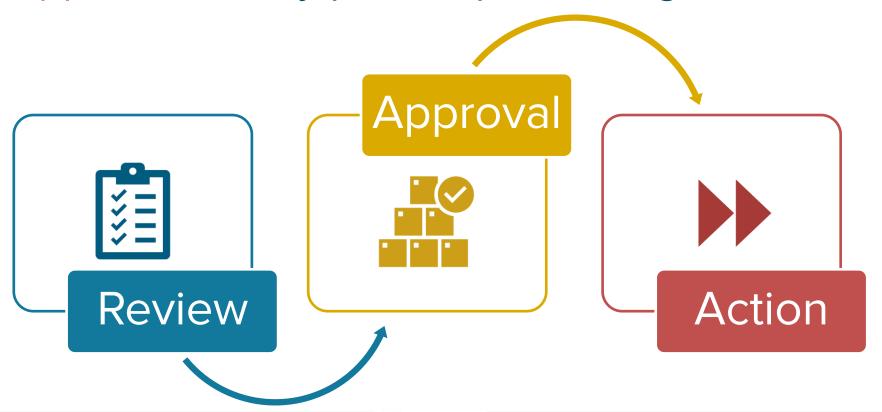

System. SI-Bone is focused on helping patients in one of the most under-served,
under-diagnosed, and under-treated areas in orthopedics, the sacroiliac (SI)
joint.

#### How were purchases managed prior to iPurchase™?

- Paper requisition routed for approval manually
- Manual entry of each data field on a paper form
- Excel spreadsheet used to track final approval
- PO Maintenance in QAD used by limited users to generate the PO

- ✓ Eliminate manual entry and handling of PO Requisitions.
- ✓ Reduce cycle time from Requisition → PO creation.

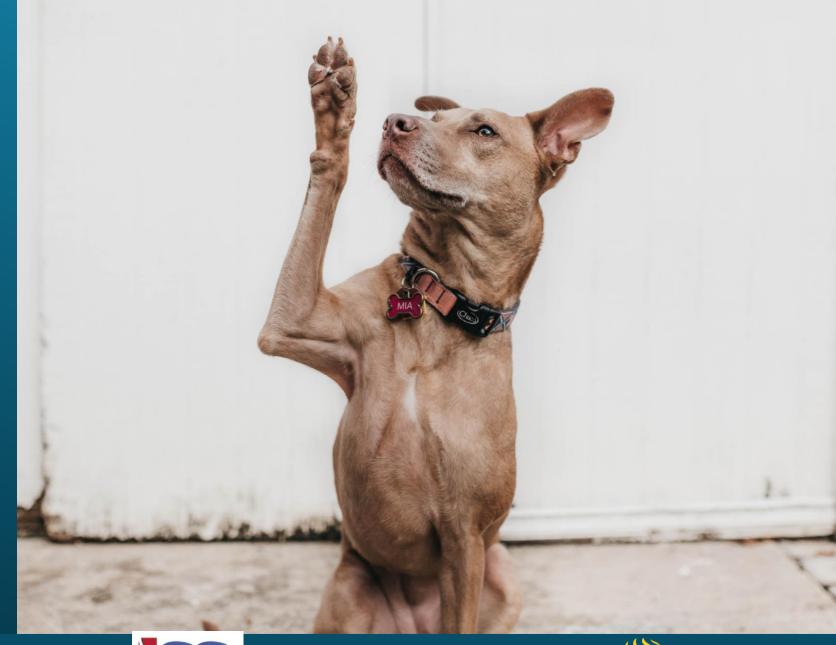
